Nash, a chocolate lab found abandoned in icy frigid conditions last December, was running on three legs. Twenty-five pounds underweight, he was probably only a few days from dying of exposure and

starvation. His rear leg was unusable and atrophied, caused by painful bone rubbing on bone. A femoral head ostectomy relieved the pain in his hip and gave him more mobility. Nash is a gentle, well mannered dog with a loving nature and would be grateful to find his very own loving forever family.

Smokey York County SPCA



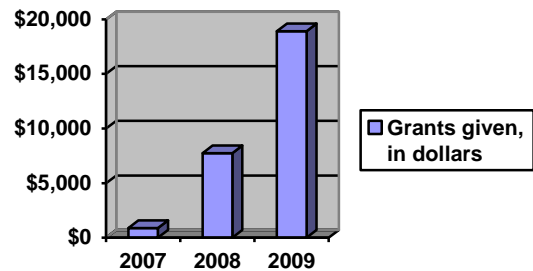
Smokey is a very sweet 14 month old black lab who had to be removed from an abusive situation. He had a wound on his face and was limping. Smokey was
